


# PREVENTING THEFT FROM SECURE CAR PARKS



- ✓ Does the car park have secured access – keypad / swipe card / other?
- ✓ Are the fences of a secure enough height to prevent easy access?
- ✓ Are there warning signs displayed?  
**Warning:** Trespassers will be prosecuted  
**Warning:** Card access required for entry  
**Warning:** CCTV cameras in operation
- ✓ Is there security lighting installed (sensor activated / timer floodlights)?
- ✓ Is there enough lighting inside the premises?
- ✓ Is there a perimeter fence?
- ✓ Use white light to illuminate areas, particularly those near CCTV.
- ✓ Do the CCTV cameras cover the entrances and exits?
- ✓ Is the security lighting tested for function every month?
- ✓ Is there CCTV coverage of the area?

# OWNERS

1. All gates / access to premises should be shut and locked at all times
2. Warning signs should be displayed prominently
3. Landscaping should be maintained regularly with trees and shrubs near entrances trimmed to reduce opportunities for concealment
4. Consider incorporating a duress facility into the alarm system

5. Control of swipe cards should be closely monitored by management utilising a property register
6. Ensure all tenants are required to "swipe in" individually

# USERS

7. Ensure tenants do not "caravan" into the car park – i.e. follow the vehicle in front
8. Have tenants stop their vehicle no more than 1½ car lengths inside the car park to prevent vehicles following without swiping in
9. Be assertive. Challenge persons, from the safety of your vehicle if necessary, who attempt to walk in behind you
10. Wait for the gates / doors behind you to close before moving off
11. If in doubt, call **131 444** for non-emergency Police attendance.
12. If you are faced with a life threatening emergency, call **000**. Remain in your car with doors and windows locked.
