Notes:

- (a) Includes all breath tests conducted during Random Breath Testing (RBT) operations or as a consequence of stopping a vehicle for a reason other than an RBT, and breath tests performed at crashes.
- (b) Enactment of the *Road Traffic Amendment Act 2008* in July 2008 resulted in changes to the impounding provisions. Legislation proclaimed in July 2009 expanded the definition of an impounding offence (driver's licence) so that it encompassed other kinds of unauthorised driving, such as when a court has imposed a licence disqualification upon the driver.
