Any person, who in the ordinary course of their business, carries or stores a firearm or ammunition for another person in Western Australia is required to be provided an exemption by the Commissioner of Police (or delegate), Section 8(1)(g) Firearms Act 1973

The Western Australia Police Force, Licensing Services (Firearms) can provide the exemption to become an 'Approved Carrier' if the following requirements are met:

- Driver/s to have a police clearance certificate or be subject to an appropriate probity regime as designated by the employer.
- When firearms are transported they must be 'rendered safe' and be concealed or covered.
- Rendered safe includes:
  - A locked container or
  - An approved box or container where the firearms are secured with a trigger locking device or has the bolt removed and the bolt is posted separately from the firearm.
- The box or container is not to be marked that it contains firearms or ammunition.
- That all reasonable precautions are taken to ensure that the firearms are not lost or stolen whilst being conveyed.
- Firearms and ammunition to be transported/stored separately.
- It is the responsibility of the transport company to have appropriate storage facilities and processes to prevent the loss or theft of firearms or ammunition whilst awaiting despatch at a depot, warehouse or similar area.
- If firearms or ammunition require storing overnight then a warehousing approval is required. Conditions for the warehousing approval are negotiable with Firearms Licensing Services.
- Motorcycles or pushbikes cannot be used for courier delivery; and
- Delivery is only to a dealer/repairer or manufacturer not to a private firearm licence holder.
