

PAYWAVE/PAYPASS CARDS ARE LIKE CASH - SECURE THEM

» Personal Owners

- Secure your payWave/PayPass cards at all times.
- Purchases under \$100 don't require a signature or PIN.
- Don't leave cards unsecured at home.
- Never leave your purse/wallet in your car.
- Watch your purse/wallet whilst shopping.
- Secure your letterbox by securing a lock or organise for your bank to send your cards to a secure location (i.e. post office box if possible).
- Report lost or stolen cards immediately to your bank.
- Never lend your payWave/PayPass card to anyone.

BEWARE OF PAYWAVE/PAYPASS FRAUD

» Business Owners

- The convenience of payWave/PayPass cards means that they are an easy target for thieves.
- Be alert to customers who appear anxious, or in a hurry.
- If you are unsure or suspicious, ask for additional identification.
- Don't be a hero, put your safety first. Most banks offer fraud money-back guarantees.
- If you suspect fraudulent activity observe and report it to Police or Crime Stoppers.
