

Safety tips & Advice

TAXIS

Some safety tips to keep in mind when catching a taxi:-

- Always be aware of your surroundings and mindful of your personal safety.
- Check the ID picture of the taxi driver matches the actual driver. The taxi driver's ID is normally on the dashboard or the windscreen visor. If it doesn't match leave the taxi.
- Jot down the taxi's plate number.
- Book your taxi through a taxi company.
- On Friday and Saturday nights, use the secure taxi ranks in Northbridge or Fremantle.
- If travelling alone, sit in the back seat of the taxi.
- If you are going to be travelling alone, limit your alcohol intake.
- If you are intoxicated, make sure someone else accompanies you in the taxi. By law a taxi driver is not required to carry intoxicated passengers.

- Taxi ID card number;
- Taxi plate number;
- Date, time and location;
- Description of the driver;
- Any other details you think are important.
